2. In order to submit this application your associate degree program must be affiliated with the SON at UNC Charlotte.
3. Application to the Early Entry RN to BSN program must be submitted to your Associate Degree Nursing Program. After submission, the application will be shared with UNC Charlotte.

1. All acceptances to the Early Entry RN to BSN Curriculum are conditional until verification of
 - Completion of the Associate Degree in Nursing.
 - Completion of all required courses with a C or better including University general education and nursing prerequisites prior to beginning the Upper Division.
 - Cumulative 3.0 GPA.
 - Submitted copies of your current and unrestricted RN license once obtained.
2. All students in the RN to BSN Completion Program must meet all graduation requirements and complete:
 - A minimum of 122 semester hours
 - University general education requirements
 - All nursing prerequisite courses
 - 31 hours of the RN-to-BSN nursing curriculum with a grade of C or better.
 - NURN 3103 for University credits to be awarded for previous nursing coursework.
3. All students must be admitted to UNC Charlotte.
 - Application to the University of North Carolina Charlotte will be completed at a later date.

 - There is a fee for the University application.
 - The student is responsible for completing the University application package as directed by the University by the established due dates.
4. Applicants must have an available clinical site through their employment or College approved agency. You can check with the RN to BSN coordinator related to specific requirements.
